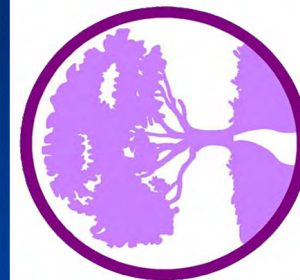

## PROGRAM AT-A-GLANCE

- Initial Assessment & 26 week sessions
- Each weekly class is 90 minutes
- Facilitators will introduce participants to several appropriate self-management techniques including problem solving, conflict resolution, and communication.
- Weekly class topics include: accepting responsibility, effective communication, respect, effect of domestic violence on children and family members, and more.
- Must attend all sessions.

## FAQ's

### Who Qualifies for the Program?

This 26-week state-approved program has been developed to meet the needs of:

- Individuals referred by their attorney as part of a plea or agreement
- Individuals approved to complete pre-trial intervention
- Individuals identified as perpetrators of criminal domestic violence and court-ordered to complete a batterer intervention program
- Individuals referred by other community agencies or other entities requiring completion of a certified anger management course
- Individuals desiring to improve his or her anger management skills.

### Need Additional Help?

In addition to weekly classes, each participant will be assessed and referred for more intensive professional evaluation and intervention by a mental health or community agency if needed.
